**Release Waiver & Consent:** This is to certify that the above named player is my dependent and has my permission to participate in the Glenwood Springs Soccer Club's program. I understand that participation in this sports program could result in injury and I do hereby release on behalf of myself and my dependent, the GSSC and its affiliated Organizations, the coaches, referees, and any other individuals or agencies connected in any way with the GSSC from any liability. As the parent or legal guardian of the above-named player, I hereby give my consent for emergency care undertaken by authorized field personnel (coach, referees, club volunteers, etc.) followed by emergency care prescribed by a duly licensed Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Dentistry or other health care provider for the player identified above. This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve the life, limb, or well being of my dependent.

**Refund Policy:** Refunds will be granted if the player moves out of the GSSC service area, if the player is unable to participate due to injury or illness as documented by a physician, or if a written request for refund is submitted to GSSC before the first game of the season. Refunds granted will be subject to a 50% processing fee. Refunds will not be granted if a special request cannot be honored, if there are conflicts with practice or game schedules, after the first game of the season, or for amounts less than \$10.00.

# CODE of CONDUCT AGREEMENT

As a PARENT . LEGAL GUARDIAN . COACH . PLAYER involved with the Glenwood Springs Soccer Club, I agree to abide by and follow these rules and guidelines.

## **Players,** for the good of the game:

- \* Understand and display appropriate game behavior.
- \* Focus on the parts of the game that you can control (fitness, positioning, skill and decision making).
- \* Do not focus on those parts of the game you cannot control (condition of the field, the referee, the weather, the opponent).

## **Parents/Guardians/Coaches,** for the good of the game:

- \* Applaud superior play by both teams.
- \* Encourage good sportsmanship through your actions by demonstrating positive support for all players.
- \* Give consistent support to coaches, volunteers, and team managers. Most coaches are committed to their own continued improvement as a coach.
- \* Provide congratulations in wining, and your encouragement when we lose.
- \* Allow the coach to do his/her job of coaching. You are not the coach -Please defer to the club provided personnel for that purpose. Do not offer instruction that is counter productive to the instruction the coach is already providing.
- \* Give your support to the officials working with the athletes to provide a positive experience for all.
- \* Promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of your personal desire to win.
- \* Remember that your child plays soccer for his/her enjoyment, not yours.
- \* Avoid remarks toward players when they make mistakes. Recognize that if you are aware of the error, the player is even more aware.
- \* Treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with dignity. Do not use improper language, poor attitude, behavior, or mannerisms (e.g. foul language, obscene gestures, etc.).
- \* Demand that your athlete treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
- \* Never taunt any player, coach, or official. We want our coaches to worry about their players, not parents. The players should enjoy their experience, especially on game day, and not have adults interfere with their games in a negative manner.
- \* Understand that making physical contact with any coach, player, or official will result in your immediate expulsion from the field, and ultimately from the club.

Feedback on player, coach, parent, and referee behavior is welcome through the appropriate avenue. The best manner is to contact a board member by calling the club office or sending an email to [soccer@sopris.net](mailto:soccer@sopris.net).

Under no circumstances should negative feedback be given to the referee during a match. All feedback should be directed to the Referee Assignor or the Director of Referees. The Assignor and Director can be contacted through the club office.

Field closures are made only after careful assessment of field and weather conditions. Under no circumstances will abuse of any referee, board member, or club staff member be tolerated regarding field closures. All feedback should be directed to the board by calling the club offices or sending an email to [soccer@sopris.net](mailto:soccer@sopris.net).

Persons who cannot conduct themselves in the above manner are not welcome at Glenwood Springs Soccer Club soccer matches. Individuals who persist in violating this Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the playing area by the referee and play will be suspended until they do. Failure to respond to such a request within 2 minutes will result in forfeiture against the offending player, coach, parent or spectator's side.
