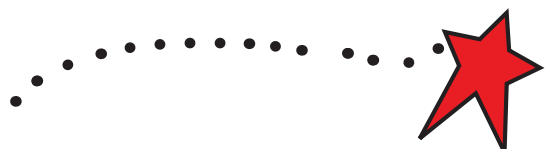

This spring Glenwood ICE rostered 363 players U6 to U18 and these 34 volunteer coaches made it all happen!

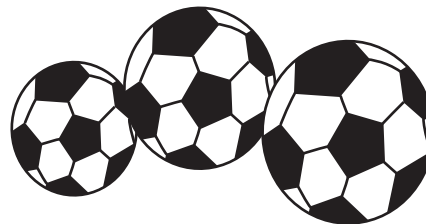
